



SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS/CEO WILD ROSE SCHOOL DIVISION No. 66

Due to the retirement of the incumbent, applications are invited for the position of Superintendent of Schools/CEO for Wild Rose School Division No. 66. Duties will commence July 1, 2015 or as mutually agreed.

THE DIVISION

Wild Rose School Division serves a stable enrolment of 5100 students in 18 schools, including three alternate schools, and employs 306 FTE teachers and 308 non-teaching staff. The Division serves the communities of Rocky Mountain House, Drayton Valley, Caroline, Leslieville, Condor and Breton.

We are located in central Alberta between the major cities of Calgary and Edmonton. The Division's central office is located in Rocky Mountain House, one hour west of Red Deer.

The Division's operating budget for 2014/2015 is \$62,000,000.

A six-member Board of Trustees was elected for a four-year term in October 2013.

THE REGION

With the beautiful Rocky Mountains as the backdrop of our location, we cover a large geographical area, from James River (south of Caroline) to 10 km north of Drayton Valley, west to the Banff National Park boundary and east including Breton, Leslieville, Condor and Caroline.

The communities we serve represent a cross-section of industry including oil and gas, lumber, agriculture, professional and business. The area features diverse landscapes, beautiful scenery and numerous lakes, providing abundant recreational opportunities, including golfing, skiing, hiking, camping, hunting, and fishing.

THE CANDIDATE

The successful candidate will possess the following key strengths:

- respect for and ability to work effectively with an elected Board and make the Board's will a reality
- demonstrated ability to provide hands-on support and mentorship to school-based leaders
- ability to strengthen a culture of accountability
- ability to build respectful, strong working relationships

The Board seeks a leader with significant, successful, broad-based educational leadership experience, ideally at both the school and system levels.

The successful candidate must qualify for Alberta teaching certification and hold an acceptable Master's degree.
